## MATCH DAY PROCEDURES FOR SUBJUNIOR TEAMS

### 1. Match Day General.

Your team manager's bag should contain the following items for match day.

- A. **Match Ball** to be supplied to referee for home games only.
- B. **Goalkeeper gloves.**
- C. **Goalkeeper top** which will come with shirts but is best kept in Managers bag as goalkeepers in sub juniors are rarely the same person each week.
- D. **Emergency Kit.** (Should have whistle in for referee)
- E. **Achievement awards** that can be used at home canteen to get free sausage or drink. Should be sufficient awards for each league match (18). Decision can be given by yourself or coach though try to share them around within the team.
- F. **Captains Armband.** It is important that different children within the team get the opportunity to wear the arm band and perform the toss when sub juniors so perhaps the child that wins the achievement award could get the opportunity to be captain the following week.

### 2. Match Day U8's

- U8's a **referee for home games will be supplied by the club on most occasions.** It would be wise to try and line a parent up to referee if a match official is unable to attend. If you are unable to get a parent to assist contact the Coaching Co ordinator as he may be able to volunteer an older Junior player. If you still have problems the opposition may be able to assist. The coach should only referee if there is **ABSOLUTELY NO OTHER ALTERNATIVE.**
- Ensure rostered parents are present to take over their canteen duties.
- **Nets and corner flags** will need to be put up and then put away after the home matches. The U8's play on the permanent small pitch. Re **mark lines** as necessary. Ensure nets are placed in correct wheelie bin marked U8's.
- Ensure **results** are communicated to Publicity Officer by recording on white board in the canteen kitchen.

### 3. Match Day U9's

- U9's a **referee for home games will be supplied by the club on most occasions.** It would be wise to try and line a parent up to referee if a match official is unable to attend. f you are unable to get a parent to assist contact the Coaching Coordinator as he may be able to volunteer an older Junior player. If you still have problems the opposition may be able to assist. The coach should only referee if there is **ABSOLUTELY NO OTHER ALTERNATIVE.**
- Ensure rostered parents are present to take over their canteen duties
- **Nets and corner flags** will need to be put up and then put away after the home matches. The U9's play across the main pitch using the half size goals. External **Lines** can be marked using plastic Hacky Sacks with semi circles marked with line marker to give penalty areas and a light centre line for half way. Ensure nets are placed in correct wheelie bin marked U9's and **goals are moved at least 4 metres from pitch area after completion of the match.**
- Ensure **results** are communicated to Publicity Officer by recording on white board in the canteen kitchen.
